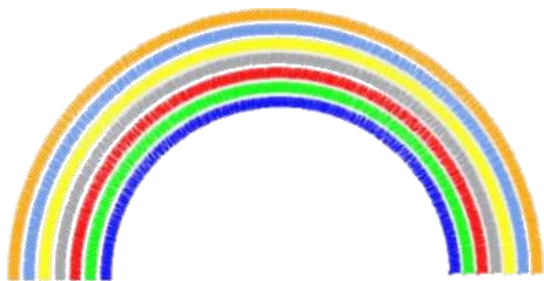

1 Create a new object for a colored arch.

2

When scene starts

Place at
x: 100 y: 300

Start zigzag stitch with length 2
and width 10

Point in direction 0 degrees

Repeat 60 times

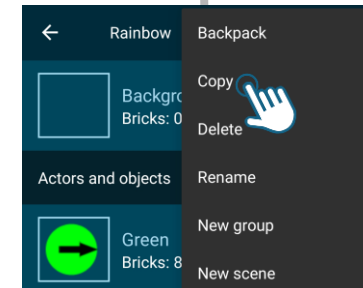
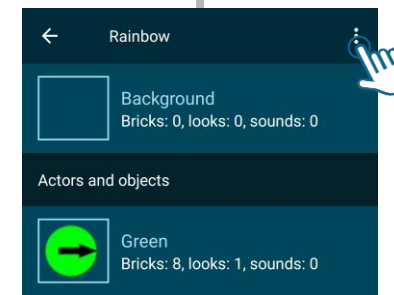
Turn left $180 \div 60$ degrees

Move 10 steps

End of loop

3 Copy the object you just created. Click on the dots in the top right corner of the object overview. Then "Copy" and select the object. Confirm with the "tick" at the left top.

If you split your design into several objects, you can embroider it in different colors.



4 Go to the scripts of the copied object and change the values in the following blocks to adapt the arc:

- "Place at x: __ y: __"
- "Repeat __ times"
- "Turn left __ degrees"

The next arch is a little bigger and starts further to the right. For the next arcs you could use the following x-values: 115, 130, 145, 160, 175, 190

Larger arcs need more stitches, so the number of repetitions will change. Try the following repetitions: 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90

Turn left $180/\text{number of loop passes}$ (see semicircle)

5 Repeat 3) and 4) for more arcs.
