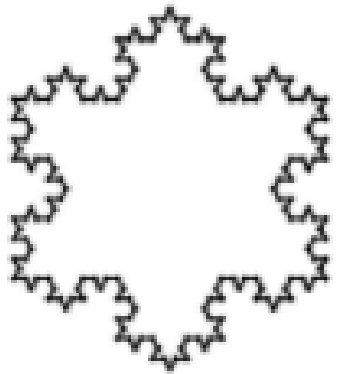


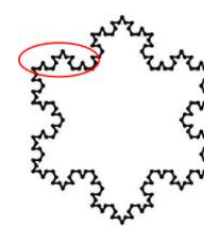

When scene starts

- Stitch
- Set variable length to 10
- Broadcast and wait koch curve

If you order one spike behind another, you can create a bigger spike ...

When you receive oneSpoke

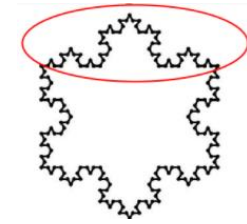
- Move "length" steps
- Stitch
- Turn left 60 degrees
- Move "length" steps
- Stitch
- Turn right 120 degrees
- Move "length" steps
- Stitch
- Turn left 60 degrees
- Move "length" steps
- Stitch

4

When you receive spikes

- Broadcast and wait oneSpoke
- Turn left 60 degrees
- Broadcast and wait oneSpoke
- Turn right 120 degrees
- Broadcast and wait oneSpoke
- Turn left 60 degrees
- Broadcast and wait oneSpoke

Create one spike:



... and if you repeat this step again and create a triangle you get a nice snowflake.

When you receive koch curve

- Repeat 3 times
- Broadcast and wait spikes
- Turn left 60 degrees
- Broadcast and wait spikes
- Turn right 120 degrees
- Broadcast and wait spikes
- Turn left 60 degrees
- Broadcast and wait spikes
- Turn right 120 degrees
- End of loop

If it doesn't work, control the bricks.
